Certainly any of thee who have watched the tube of mysticism called the "TV" this one year hence have no doubt see the images of the market criers for the *%#!? that is known as "Bud Light". In this sham of a theater, the members... Yay! Verily, the king of this strange kingdom decry the poor tavener who called for mead, and he is oft depicted in a dungeon or worse why the mocking sounds of "Dilly Dilly" float from above.

Well I am here to tell you that mead is a delight. An art form that has been explored for thousands of years, since even the most ancient of our ancestors can tell no tale. Mead making is like the "subtle science and extract art of potion making" that a famous professor at some obscure school once spoke of. For mead can be crafted in such a wide range of flavors and strengths that unless one has an allergy to the golden nectar honey itself, one is sure to find a bottle and a style that suites the palette.

My own experiences are scat more than a year past learning at the skilled hands of Lady Isabell Henry, but I am fast approaching a milestone of some trepidation: entering my mead into a Brewing Competition. I need three different types of mead to enter and I now have just that. My plan is to enter my straight mead, my Vikings blood (brewed with cherry juice), and my Bilbemel, (back-sweetened with Blueberries and vanilla bean). We shall see what great palettes than mine have to say.

But Brewing mead has presented me with some difficulties in adjusting the sweetness of my mead. Adding the blueberry puree to back-sweeten the bilbemel did not sweeten it as I expected. It seems the blueberries were not sweet enough naturally to do it. So, further research was called for and testing done. The adding of additional honey after the fermentation is done does seem to have been a popular recommendation, but how much and how to blend has been difficult to determine. So far one attempt to add honey to a separate vessel of straight mead has resulted in the honey not blending, but rather, sinking to the bottom and remaining separate...

What to do! And time is running out, with Rip Rap war (III) only about a month from present, stay tuned. Or better yet, come to Rip Rap War and tastes some mead and see if it's sweet enough for you...






