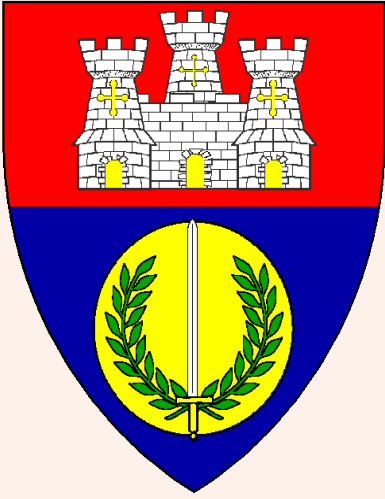

From the Baronage

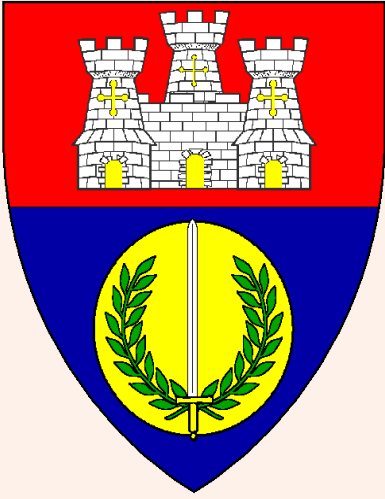
Unto Our Beloved Members of the Barony,

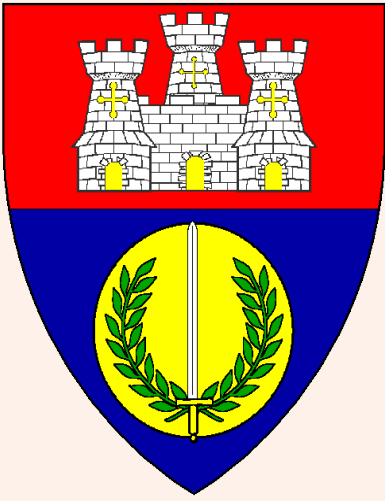

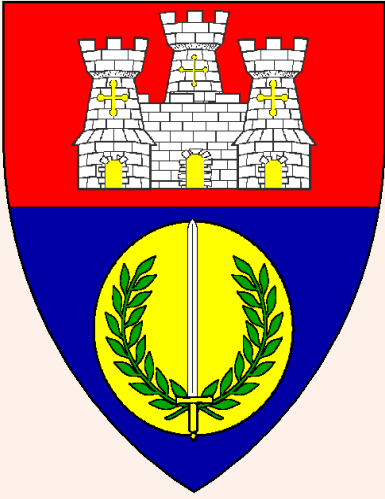

 - Small water heater is needed for the showers

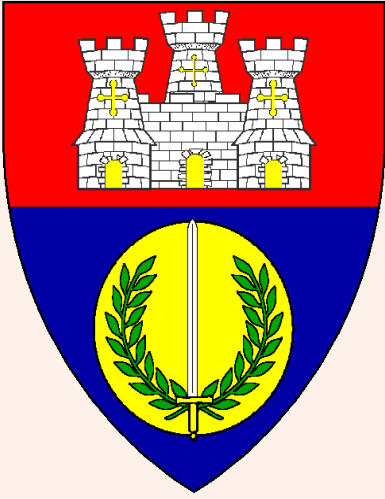
Old Business:
