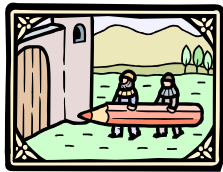
## Cear G Demo to be held at Old Farm Day

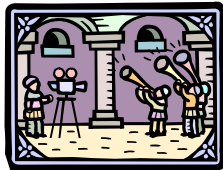

## Message from the Baron and Baroness

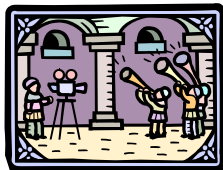

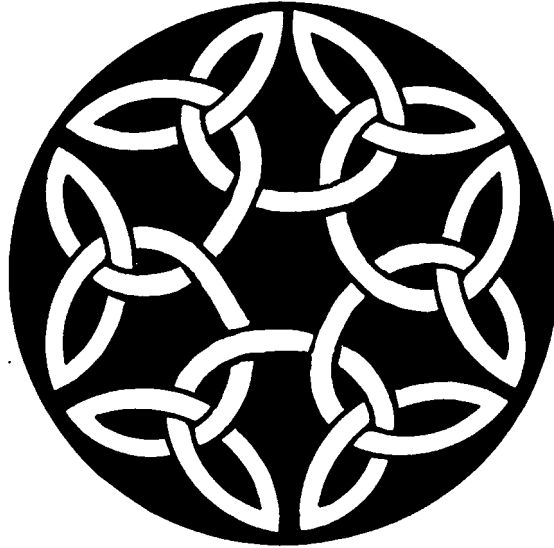


## Message from Baron William Cameron
