We are being provided space, a table, and chairs to use. Fiber Arts & other hands-on demonstrations for public education and fun have been requested by the event coordinator.

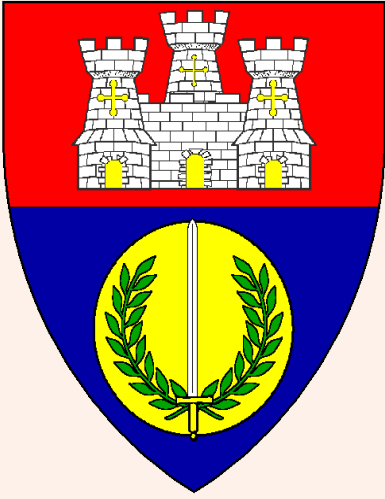
