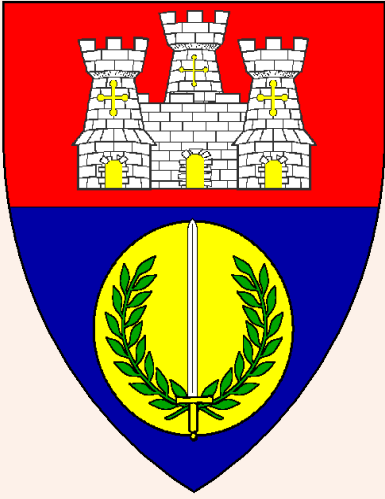

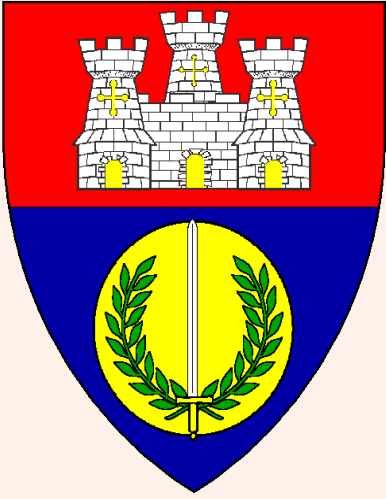


From the Baronage

To the Populous of Caer Mear,

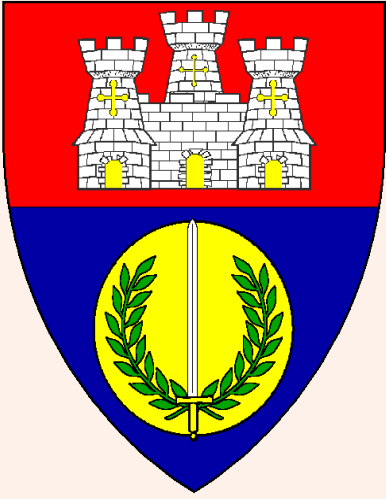

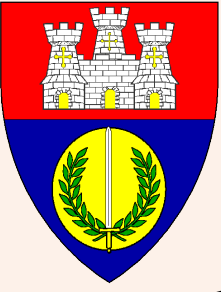

Caer Mear On the Move

The Athlete's Tale, is a Facebook Group based upon the Canterbury Tales. This group was created by Caer Mear's own Meriorie Matheson, with the goal of keeping Caer Mearian's on the move. Meriorie has combined her knowledge of Medieval literature and fitness to take us on a journey to Canterbury Cathedral. In the Canterbury Tales, pilgrims on the road to Canterbury Cathedral told stories to entertain themselves. Meriorie will be hosting a pilgrimage challenge, where athletes can motivate and encourage each other to complete the challenge while having a bit of fun along the way. The challenge runs from January 1, 2021 to March 31, 2021. All pilgrims will start in the Winchester Cathedral. From there you will follow an ancient track through Southeast England, ending at the shrine of Saint Thomas Becket in Canterbury Cathedral. During this journey of 153 miles, you will have the opportunity to grow and develop your speed, strength, stamina, and prowess for the honor of your kingdom. 1 mile of walking, hiking, running, cycling, rowing, and/or skating will count for 1 mile on the pilgrimage. 750 yards of swimming will count as 1 mile. 1 hour of weightlifting will count for 5 miles on the pilgrimage. 1 hour of archery/equestrian practice will count for 5 miles. 50 pell shots will count for 1 mile on the pilgrimage. (Maximum of 100 pell shots a day.) If you have another activity that you want to do that isn't listed here, like dance, I'm happy to work with you to translate that activity to miles on the Pilgrim's Path. <https://www.facebook.com/groups/theathletestale>". Sicilian Whole Orange Cake

Ingredients

- 3 eggs
- 1 1/8 c (250g) sugar
- 1 3/4 c (275g) all purpose flour
- 2 1/2 tsp baking powder (or 1 packet Italian Pane Degli Angeli vanilla baking powder)
- 1/3 c (100g) butter, softened
- 1/3 c (100g) plain Greek yogurt
- 1 large organic orange, about (300g), washed and cut into pieces (with the rind, but remove the seeds) (if using plain baking powder add 1 tsp vanilla extract)

Glaze

- juice of one organic orange
- 1/3 c (100g) sugar

Instructions

Preheat oven to 350°F (175°C)

Make the whole orange cake

Prepare an [8" springform pan](#) by spraying with oil (or butter) and lining in parchment paper (sides optional, if you want really clean sides), then spray the paper, too.

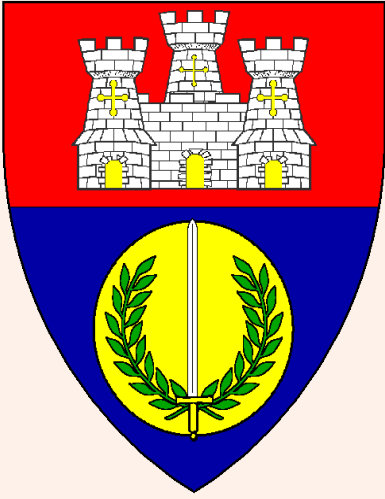
1. Place the sugar and eggs in a large bowl and beat with a mixer until light and fluffy.
2. Sift the flour with the baking powder then add to the mixture in the bowl a little at a time along with the softened butter. Continue to mix until completely blended, then stir in the yogurt.
3. In a food processor, process the whole orange until it is almost pureed.
4. Add this orange to the cake mixture (along with the vanilla if you used plain baking powder) and stir until evenly combined, then put the batter into the prepared tin.

Bake for 50-60 minutes (depending on your oven), but test with a [cake tester](#) or skewer to make sure the orange cake is done before removing from the oven. Allow to cool for about 15 minutes, then remove the side of the springform pan.

Make the orange glaze

1. Prepare the glaze by melting the sugar in the orange juice and allow to simmer for a few minutes, just until the liquid has a syrupy consistency.

Spoon and [brush](#) over the top of the cake and allow to cool completely before cutting.
