Announcements

- According to Kingdom as of June 1, 2021 all activities may resume with the caveat of these restrictions:
 - Masks that fully cover the mouth and nose must be worn by **ALL ATTENDEES** over the age of 4 at all times, indoors (restrooms, etc.) and outside; and during all physical activities, except for eating and drinking
 - Court, bardic circles, or any activity that involves voice projection shall also require that mask be worn at all times. Sound amplification devices are highly recommended
 - No day board, water bearing, or prepared food of any kind shall be provided by event staff or attendees to other attendees
 - No overnight camping shall be allowed
 - All events must be held outdoors to include in-person business meetings, A&S and practices
 - All events will have a mandatory maximum of 150 attendees
 - All events will require a preregistration

We also had an Arts and Science Competition presented by Lady Eadyth Woderose. 
