Business Meeting Notes

Old Business:

- Caer Mear Coronation for Oct 1, 2022
- Fall University at Louisa Middle School, September 17th, 2022

University - after an exhausting and awful few days, the new school administration has agreed to accept the agreement made between the SCA and Louisa Middle school back in the spring. They had tried to pull a last-minute switch on us and charge \$30 per classroom on top of the \$310 for the custodian. University Chancellor, Dame Kilmeny was able to get it fixed and University is on for this Saturday. What this means going forward though is that if Caer Mear wants to host University again we'll need a new place. Thank goodness we have two other teachers in Caer Mear. But that's a common refrain right now (more sites).

Coronation - I will be picking up a truck on Thursday and loading the list fence, a shower head, all the hoses, the sink and the tents Thursday afternoon. I will post on the CM page what time I'm going to be at the shed if anyone is available to help load the truck. We are going to use the 15x15 as Troll/gold key and I'm grabbing the 12x12 in case we need it.

Sir Bryce is bringing a tent to use as the Royal Room and Mistress Magdalena is bringing her kitchen tent. The feast will be held under the big top, and Their Excellencies are bringing their own tent. My family has one of the mundane single person shower tents and I will be setting that up and not the Shower Tent (tm) that we use for Joust. I just need to figure out a small privacy enclosure for it. Might be an easy up with tarp "walls". Registration is going very slowly; we need 200 for break even and we're only at 98. Please poke your friends!! I have to give Neily a number to buy for very soon and right now feast pre-reg is at only 50. I need everyone's help pushing this for us!!

Yesterday I received an update from the Kingdom seneschal regarding covid policy per Society Board of Directors.

"They have decided that due to changes in the national strategies for the COVID situation, effective December 1, 2022, all prior requirements including social distancing, masking, vaccinations, and testing under the COVID Safe policy will be lifted. This includes any restrictions that were left to the individual Kingdoms to determine."

Please note that this does not go into effect until Dec 1, 2022, will also note from Seneschal list discussion that if a site has covid restrictions then we must follow whatever they are.
