From the Baronage

Greetings everyone from your Baron and Baroness,

Welcome to the scorching summer months. For those of you busily packing for Pennsic, we wish you smooth efforts, safe travels, and an uneventful return. We look forward to everyone sharing their stories from Pennsic, the sights seen, deeds done, and purchases bought!

We have settled into the new storage location and have an eye on moving again this fall to an even less expensive location. Either way, all the work of our helpful members has cleaned up a lot of items that were no longer useable, enabled a cleaned-up layout in the new storage location, and in many ways greatly improved the state of Baronial gear.

Weekly fight practices and gathers continue at the Moose Lodge just south of Ashland on Tuesday nights. It has become a "go to" practice for armored fighters with a large number of Knights and Royal Peers in attendance. Our rapier fighters also have a solid practice with regular visits from neighboring fighters. Others come and hang out at the many benches and tables, doing A&S projects, conducting Baronial and Kingdom business, and just visiting and hanging out. There will be the typical break around Pennsic but if you haven't attended in a while, please come grace us with your presence in mid/late August as we pick back up after Pennsic and the temperatures start moving back to fall comfort.

As everyone probably knows by now, Her Excellency and I stepped up to watch over Caer Mear as it's Baronage back in March, 2001. The initial tenure of Baronage runs 3 full years. We were looking to step down at that time, but we strongly wanted to re-align the turnover of the Baronage back to our capstone event of Ruby Joust in late May. Unfortunately to do this put the transition into the reign of Crowns not yet chosen until this November as HRH Ragnar and Mary Isabel will step up and King and Queen in October and step down next April. The de-Investure and Investiture of new Baronage must take place at a royal progress event and the decision of the Baronage must be made by the Crowns doing the investiture.

Chancellor of Youth-Vacant

While we felt we had started in plenty of time with the help and direction of Master William, we were obviously not nearly quick enough. Even the timeline schedule from the Senechals office urges one to talk to the new Heirs within a week or two of them winning Crown Tourney. When contacted, HRH pointed out that they only had 3 open weekends during the full span of their reign. At that point, we were left with a only few choices if we still wanted to step down right away. None of these choices were very optimal either.

The first option was to find a volunteer to autocrat a new event specifically for the Investiture process with only 3 or fewer choices for weekends to make it happen. If we managed that, we would then have to squeeze the entire candidate process and Baronial polling into the time remaining before that event. We have a number of amazing works and skilled autocrats but we rely on the energy and charity of volunteers to put such an event together.

The next option was to talk to the BoD for a variance to extend our reign nearly 2 months to Ruby Joust. Given the current stress and drama going on at the Society level plus experience with such things given by former and current Crowns, this was deemed unlikely. We would have to pin our hopes on it, wait until that process dragged out for an answer and likely be left exactly where we started.

Instead, her Excellency and I conferred with others, including HRH, and decided to push for a polling of confidence amongst the populace. This polling will go to the current Heirs for their decision when they are King and Queen. If things go well and we feel they are likely to do so, this will extend the reign of Aine and myself for another two years. Armed with our improved knowledge of the timing and requirements, our plan at the moment is to step down part way during the 2 year extension, planning for a turnover of the Baronage in 2025 at Ruby Joust. This would require contact the new heirs after Fall Crown Tourney next year in 2024 to get their acceptance and get everything on the calendar. That also then gives us plenty of time for our Seneschal to conduct the polling process and doesn't add a last-minute additional event on the Barony's calendar (and more importantly, on its coffers).

We thank everyone for your understanding as we and all of our officers strive to keep this Barony running smoothly. I hope to see many of you at Storvik's Battle on the Bay in late August as well as at the Tuesday gathers.

Love's Quiet - Documentation A Petrarchan Sonnet, named for the most well known author of this poetic style, Francesco Petrarca, is characterized by its rhyme scheme and structure. It consists of an Octave, with rhyme scheme AB-BAABBA, and a sestet, with rhyme scheme CDCDCD. Originally an Italian renaissance poetic form, when written in English, the common hendecasyllabic meter is changed to iambic pentameter (similar to other sonnet forms of the period, such as the Shakespearean sonnet). It was also common for these sonnets to feature love as a key theme, frequently with the octave presenting a "problem" or scenario, followed by a twist, or solution, in the sestet. Franscesco Petrarca, known as Petrach in the English-speaking world, lived in Tuscany in the early to mid 14th century. One of his best known works was Il Canzoniere, the Song Book, one of the first poetic works published in the Italian vernacular, and featuring 366 poems, the majority of which were sonnets of the style described above.
